

NATWEST 6 NATIONS FANTASY RUGBY 2018

COMPETITION RULES - TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. This competition ("Competition") runs until 10pm (GMT) on Sunday 18th March 2018 and is open to residents of the United Kingdom and any other jurisdiction within the European Union in which the Competition is not prohibited or unlawful (including Italy), excluding employees of the promoter, its associated companies and agencies, their immediate families or anyone else involved in the organisation or administration of the Competition. Entrants must be 18 or over at the time they enter the Competition.
2. To enter the Competition, sign in or register at <http://fantasy.sixnationsrugby.com/> and follow the instructions for entry. Each entrant may only enter the Competition once.
3. Following the conclusion of the final match played in a round during the 2018 NatWest Six Nations Championship ("Championship"), the entrant whose team has scored the highest number of points in the relevant round (in accordance with the game rules, which are available (click on "rules of the game" once connected) will win a prize ("Weekly Prize"). In addition, following the final round of the Championship, the entrant whose team has scored the highest number of points over the course of the entire Championship will also win a prize ("Grand Prize").
4. There are 6 prizes in total:
 - (a) 5 Weekly Prizes, one for each round of the Championship, each consisting of one jersey (the winner will get to pick a jersey of his choice among the 6 participating nations); and
 - (b) the Grand Prize consists of one Ultimate NatWest 6 Nations weekend which includes : Flights from within Europe to one of the six selected city, Match tickets and Hotel accommodation (for 2 people).
5. The winners will be contacted directly by the promoter and given details of how to claim their prize. For each round:

- The highest score for the round

- then, the number of tries scored by the rugby players of each team including all the played rounds (the highest wins the prize)
- then, the number of drops scored by the rugby players of each team including all the played rounds (the highest wins the prize)
- then the number of "man of the match" players included in the line-up of each team including all the played rounds (the highest wins the prize)

- finally a lottery (if necessary)

For General Ranking (at the end of the game):

- The highest score in the competition

- then, the number of tries scored by the rugby players of each team including all the played rounds (the highest wins the prize)

- then, the number of drops scored by the rugby players of each team including all the played rounds (the highest wins the prize)

- then the number of "man of the match" players included in the line-up of each team including all the played rounds (the highest wins the prize)

- finally a lottery (if necessary)

7. The prizes are as stated and no alternatives are available. The prizes are non-transferable and may not be redeemed for cash or resold. All costs and expenses not included within the prizes are the sole responsibility of the winner(s).
